



HM AEROSPACE

ABRIDGED COURSE (CPL/IR WITH FROZEN ATPL)

The Abridged course training is required when a Malaysian citizen with a foreign CPL/IR would like to convert it into a Malaysian CPL/IR awarded by the Department of Civil Aviation (DCA) Malaysia.

MINIMUM ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- Letter of approval from the Malaysian Department of Civil Aviation
- Sijil Pelajaran Malaysia (SPM) / 'O' Levels, or its equivalent with a minimum of five (5) credits including English, Mathematics and a Science Subject
- Minimum age of seventeen (17) years
- Successful medical examination Class I with requisite certificate from DCA approved medical examiner
- Adequate competency in the English language

COURSE DURATION

- The duration of this course is about 35 weeks on a full-time basis

COURSE CONTENT

FLIGHT TRAINING

- Minimum of 35 hours of flying time on a Multi Engine aircraft (Diamond DA-42 Twin Star Glass-Cockpit Aircraft)
- Meeting the FCL requirements for CPL/IR with a breakdown of 100 hours PIC of which up to 30 hours maximum may be as pilot acting as PIC under supervision (P1 US), 50 hours on cross country navigation of which 35 hours must be as PIC, 10 hours night flying of which 5 hours must be as PIC, 25 hours of DUAL Instrument Flying and any other requirements as deemed necessary. Total flying experience must not be less than 200 hours

GROUND TRAINING

Must attend Ground theory lessons and must pass the following examination papers of JAA Phase II and Phase III:

- **JAA Phase II**
 - General Navigation
 - Flight Planning & Monitoring
 - Radio Navigation
 - Meteorology
 - Instrumentation
- **JAA Phase III**
 - Performance
 - Mass & Balance
 - Human Performances & Limitations
 - Air Law I & II
 - Operational Procedures
 - Type Technical - Twin Engine (DA-42)

Pass an Assessment flight test (GFT/IR) by DCA Examiner

- The theory examination paper (JAA 5 papers) must be taken at ATPL level



On completion of the course, the pilot is able to convert a foreign pilot's licence to Malaysian pilot's licence.
