HM Aerospace offers our cadet pilots a range of aviation courses. Our courses are conducted in accordance with the requirements of the Department of Civil Aviation (DCA) Malaysia.

The License examinations are conducted by the Malaysian Department of Civil Aviation (DCA) and United Kingdom Civil Aviation Authority International (UK CAAI). Courses cater for, cadets who are sponsored by commercial airline companies, private cadets fresh out of secondary school, overseas cadets as well as adults who meet the qualifying requirements. Our course duration ranges from three (3) to eighteen (18) months.

ADMISSION PROCEDURES



For Malaysian Applicants

- To submit completed HM Aerospace (HMA) Application Form with the following documents:
 - 2 copies of Certified True Copy of Applicant's NRIC
 - 2 copies of Certified True Copy of Applicant's SPM and/or any other related academic qualifications results
 - 2 copies of Certified True Copy of Sponsor's NRIC
 - 6 passport size photographs (non-returnable)
 - Letter of Approval from the Malaysian Department of Civil Aviation (DCA). If the applicant has not obtained approval of DCA, HMA will facilitate in submitting application and documents to DCA
 - 2 copies of Medical Class I Certificate (Class II for Private Pilot's Licence Course) issued by DCA approved medical examiner
- HMA will issue a Conditional Offer Letter upon receiving the above documents
- The applicant is required to pay the enrolment fee of RM10,000
- The applicant will be invited to attend a Pre-course Entrance Test and Interview
- The applicant and sponsor are required to sign the Pilot Training Course Agreement, and pay the first installment within 7 days of signing the agreement
- The remaining payment must be paid as per stated in Pilot Training Course Agreement

For International Applicants

- To submit completed HM Aerospace (HMA) Application Form with the following documents:
 - 3 copies of Certified True Copy of Applicant's passport
 - 2 copies of Certified True Copy of Applicant's academic qualifications results.
 - 2 copies of Certified True Copy of Sponsor's passport
 - 6 passport size photographs (non-returnable)
 - Letter of Approval from the Malaysian Department of Civil Aviation (DCA). If the applicant has not obtained approval of DCA, HMA will facilitate in submitting application and documents to DCA
 - 2 copies of Medical Class I Certificate obtained from the applicant's home country. Another Medical Class I (Class II for Private Pilot's Licence Course) check-up by the Malaysian Department of Civil Aviation (DCA) approved medical examiner will be required upon arrival in Kuala Lumpur
- HMA will issue a Conditional Offer Letter upon receiving the above documents
- The applicant is required to pay the enrolment fee of RM10,000 and visa processing fee of RM2,000
- The applicant and sponsor are required to sign the Pilot Training Course Agreement, and pay the first installment within 7 days of signing the agreement
- The applicant is required to attend a Pre-course Entrance Test and Interview upon arrival at HMA Langkawi Flight Centre
- The remaining payment must be paid as per stated in Pilot Training Course Agreement
